



Resurrection Religious Education: 2017 Program

Parent Covenant: Students in Grades K-8

1. Parents understand their role as the first and primary teachers of their children, and children learn best by example. As Catholics, we know that Mass is the most important part of our faith formation. Parents will teach their children as they worship at Mass every weekend.
2. Parents understand that the program is a condensed learning experience. It is essential that students attend class every week.
3. Parents will coordinate transportation for their students according to scheduled start and end times.
 - Students will arrive at Resurrection School no earlier than 6:20 PM: class begins at 6:30 PM.
 - Students will be picked up at Resurrection School no later than 7:55 PM: class ends at 7:45 PM
4. Parents will insure that their students understand the simple discipline policy. We respect each other and maintain a positive learning environment for every student.
5. All parents are encouraged to support the RE program by
 - Volunteering to assist as a classroom aide
 - Support their children by asking how they are doing with their classroom work and assisting the children by answering questions they might raise.
 - Attending any or all of the special events (Mass, Reconciliation, etc).
6. Families who attend the RE Program make a commitment to
 - Attend Mass on weekends
 - Attend Mass on Ash Wednesday
 - Attend the Living Stations of the Cross

7. Families with children in Sacramental preparation (Grade 2) who attend the School Year RE Program also make a commitment to:

- Attend Mass on weekends
- Attend the First Reconciliation Parent/Child Meetings on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 and Tuesday, October 3, 2017 from 6:30-7:30 PM. The 2nd grade children will also attend these meetings.
- Participate (with their student) in the Reconciliation interview on Tuesday, November 7, 2017 in Resurrection Church Social Space.
- Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation by participating in the Reconciliation service on Tuesday, December 5, 2017.
- Attend the First Eucharist Parent/Child Meetings scheduled for Tuesday, January 9, 2018 and Tuesday, February 6, 2018 from 6:30 – 7:30 PM. The 2nd grade children will also attend this meeting.
- Attend Mass on Ash Wednesday
- Attend the Living Stations of the Cross
- Participate (with their student) in the Eucharist interview on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 in Resurrection Church Social Space.
- Participate (with their student) in the Eucharist Retreat event on Saturday, April 14, 2018 from 8:30 – 10:45 AM at the Church.
- Celebrate the Sacrament of Eucharist on either Saturday, April 21, 2018 (4:00 PM or 6:00 PM) or Sunday, April 22, 2018. (7:00, 9:00 AM or 11:00 AM).
