



Resurrection Summer Religious Education: 2017 Parent Covenant: Students in Grades 1-8

1. The Catholic Church teaches that parents are the first and primary teachers of their children, and children learn best by example. As Catholics, we know that Mass is the most important part of our faith formation. Parents understand that they form their children in our Catholic faith as they worship together at Mass each weekend.
2. Parents understand that the summer program is a condensed learning experience. It is essential that students attend class every day during the summer session.
3. Parents will coordinate transportation for their students according to scheduled start and end times. Classes start @ 8:00 AM. Classes dismiss @ 12 Noon.
 - Students will arrive at Resurrection School no earlier than 7:50 AM
 - Children in 1st & 2nd grade must be picked up inside the building by a parent or guardian
4. Parents understand that there is a 15 minute break scheduled for each day. Parents are encouraged to send a water bottle and small snack that will not require refrigeration and does not contain nuts or nut products with their student for consumption during the 15 minute break. Water fountains are also available.
5. Parents will ensure that their students understand the simple discipline policy. We respect each other and maintain a positive learning environment for every student.
6. All parents are encouraged to support the summer program by:
 - Volunteering to assist as a classroom aide, hall monitor or other assistant during the session
 - Support their children by asking how they are doing with their classroom work and assisting the children by answering questions they might raise
 - Attending the special events during the summer session: Closing Family Mass on Thursday, June 22nd at 11:00 AM.
7. Families who attend the Summer Program make a commitment to:
 - Attend Mass on weekends
 - Attend Mass on Ash Wednesday
 - Attend other Resurrection Parish Community gatherings such as:
 - Communal Reconciliation at Resurrection Church on March 7, 2018 @ 6:30 PM
 - Living Stations of the Cross at Resurrection Church on Wednesday, March 21, 2018
 - Attend class (1st – 5th grades) at the church on Sundays from 10:05 – 10:45 AM on:

8. Families with children in Sacramental preparation (Grade 2) who attend the Summer Program also make a commitment to:
- Attend Mass on weekends and Holy Days of Obligation
 - Attend the First Reconciliation Parent/Child Meetings on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 and Tuesday, October 3, 2017 from 6:30-7:30 PM. The 2nd grade children will also attend these meetings.
 - Participate (with their student) in the Reconciliation interview on Tuesday, November 7, 2017 in Resurrection Church Social Space.
 - Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation by participating in the Reconciliation service on Tuesday, December 5, 2017.
 - Attend the First Eucharist Parent/Child Meetings scheduled for Tuesday, January 9, 2018 and Tuesday, February 6, 2018 from 6:30 – 7:30 PM. The 2nd grade children will also attend this meeting.
 - Participate (with their student) in the Eucharist interview on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 in Resurrection Church Social Space.
 - Participate (with their student) in the Eucharist Retreat event on Saturday, April 14, 2018 from 8:30 – 10:45 AM at the Church.
 - Celebrate the Sacrament of Eucharist on either Saturday, April 21, 2018 (4:00 PM or 6:00 PM) or Sunday, April 22, 2018. (7:00 AM, 9:00 AM or 11:00 AM).
