

Resurrection Fall Festival **Sunday, August 20, 2017**

Dear Parishioners,

Our Parish Festival is quickly approaching and we need your support! To help ensure another successful festival we are asking each family to donate the following:

- **\$5** toward the meat expense
- **fresh tomatoes**
- **Decaffeinated ground coffee** (not instant). (This also could be purchased through the Social Justice Committee Fair Trade project.)
- **1 pie** (last names A-N)
- **1 cake** (last names O-Z) in a disposable or recyclable container. (No cream or custard please. Brownies/bars may be substituted.)

Please also consider donating the following items:

Kiddie Land: new or gently-used prizes (value of 25-50¢ or more for children up to age 12)
(Cash donations are also welcome and should be placed in an envelope labeled "Kiddie Land.")

The Country Store: fresh fruits/vegetables, jams/jellies, pickles, baked goods, arts/crafts, etc.
(Bars should be cut into 1½-inch squares with 6 to a plate; cookies should be 13 to a plate. Please cover all baked goods with plastic wrap. Please price all craft items. **(No used items please.)**)

Sports & Novelty Wheel: new sports equipment or novelty items. Examples include balls of any type, water bottles, pool toys, beach towels, fidget spinners, athletic apparel or gear. (Cash donations are also welcome and should be placed in an envelope labeled "Sports Wheel.")

Snack Wheel: commercially packaged/sealed snacks.

Silent Auction: donated auction items or experience packages. (Cash donations are also welcome and should be placed in an envelope labeled "Silent Auction.")

What do I do with my donations? Please bring your donations to church, and drop them off with volunteers at the church entrances before and after Masses in August, or drop them off at the parish office. This includes donations of meat money, coffee, game prizes, snacks, and non-perishable country store items. ***Please bring cakes, pies, and tomatoes to Door 2 of the school the morning of the festival.**

Finally, if you have not yet sold or purchased your **Raffle Tickets**, please do so ASAP! Ticket stubs/cash can be placed in an envelope and dropped in the weekend collection basket or at the parish office.

Reminders for festival day:

- Portions of the upper and lower parking lots will be reserved for festival use only after the 9 a.m. Mass.
- Coffee and donuts will be on sale at the refreshment stand in the lower parking lot after morning Masses.
- Amusement bracelets for unlimited admission for the inflatables and the petting zoo will be sold in the lower lot near Kiddie Land on the day of the festival.
