PURPOSE: To be a minister of the Body and Blood of our Lord in a unique and privileged way

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Confirmed and a practicing Catholic, striving to live a life consistent with church teachings
- Possessed of a deep personal faith in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist
- Interested in and caring for other people without regard for status in our community

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To know your schedule, which is sent to you via e-mail or U.S. Postal Service, and is also posted on the Resurrection website (www.res-dbq.org)
- To attend training sessions as scheduled
- To be commissioned by a priest or deacon
- To follow the Guidelines for Extraordinary Ministers of Communion
- To display a reverence for and faith in the Body and Blood of Christ
- To be appropriately dressed for worship

TIME COMMITMENT:

- It is **mandatory** that Extraordinary Ministers of Communion **come to the sacristy at least 15 minutes before Mass begins**. You **must sign in**, and remain for **prayer** which Father or the deacon leads. Failure to sign in and be present for prayer may result in being removed from the schedule.
