Usher

DESCRIPTION: The Usher helps welcome participants to weekend and special liturgies conducted at our parish. He or she also helps participants find a seat, assists those with special needs, takes the collection, distributes bulletins, and assists with any participant's needs that occur during Mass.

PURPOSE: The Usher serves the needs of participants during the church service so that they can worship in a suitable environment for the service.

QUALIFICATIONS: The primary quality of the Usher is that he or she is striving to live a life consistent with church teachings. The Usher is interested in and caring for other people without regard for status in our community. She or he should be naturally upbeat, welcoming, positive and enjoy serving others.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Help to provide a welcoming environment for those who attend the liturgy
- Attend to the needs of those requiring direction or special assistance
- Assist guests in search of adequate seating for the liturgy
- Be prepared for emergency situations (training is provided)
- To find a substitute when not able to be present as scheduled
- Gather the collection during the liturgy
- Make bulletins available after the liturgy
- Assist others as they leave the worship space.
