Ministry renewal night is scheduled for Oct. 10th – please sign up if you haven’t already.</p> <p>Parish Life – It had been planned to do a coat collection again this fall, however expenses associated with this were not budgeted/ requested in advance, so it won’t be held this year, but the desire is to do it again next year. The group is re-evaluating all aspects of the summer Picnic in the Park for next year, including goals/purpose, location, date, etc.</p> <p>Social Justice – The Holy Land art sale is next weekend after masses. The Habitat for Humanity house dedication will be at 1:00 pm on Oct. 29th.</p> <p>Faith Formation – Lots of discussion around how to reach high school and middle school students that aren’t already involved.</p> <p>Stewardship – The Stewardship column in the bulletin will continue through the end of the year. A New Parishioner brunch was held last weekend and 12 families (out of 29) attended. The group discussed the Time, Talent & Treasure forms. The Stewardship talk will be the 3rd weekend in October.
